### ***WHO***

*Everybody: Malacologist, Technicians, Teachers or other peoples who are interested in freely participating to the projects forming a:*

#### ***ITMP Country Team***

*It is needed to have a "Country Team" representing the local ideas, proposal, works to share with peoples of other countries.*

*We suggest to have in a Country Team at least the following skills:*

- a Malacologist or a Biologist*
- an Information Tecnology Programmer*
- a Language Translator*
- a Teacher*

*One member of each Country Team could be assigned to the Central Project Team. While the Members of a Team are all committed to develop teaching products,*

#### ***ITMP Partners***

*may support the Country Team in the activities promoting the Project and the Products.*



# ***ITMP***

## ***International Teaching Malacology Project***

### ***WHAT***

*The First Commitments for each Country Team are:*

- ***Proposing** ideas, methods, experiences to all the country teams for a better teaching of malacology.*
- ***Selecting** project products that are of interest for his own country.*
- ***Translating** selected project products in local languages and "**Adapting**" them to the local environment and requirements.*
- ***Help and Assist** the central team to develop the project.*
- ***Distribute and Diffuse** the products of the project into the local schools, Public Institutions and Museums, Malacologists.*



# ***ITMP***

## ***International Teaching Malacology Project***

### ***HOW***

#### ***Creating a Country Team***

*step 1 - **Contact** Institutions, Museums, Malacologist of your country asking them to join the project.*

*step 2 - **Communicate** to the Central Team the required informations on the members of the Country Team.*

*step 3 - **Collect** ideas, suggestion and arguments for teaching malacology in your country*

*step 4 - **Connect** to the Central Team, sharing the products"*

#### ***Publicating collected worldwide products***

*step 1 - **Cooperate** with Central Team for selection and preparation of articles, monographs, banner, photos...*

*step 2 - **Check** the objects proposed and agreed with the Central Team for further publication.*

*step 3 - **Check** the final product and authorize the publications*

#### ***Using shared products***

*Please you have to clearly understand and agree with this general and very important principles:*

- All the products have to be authorized for free distribution.*
- All the products may be freely distributed and used but strictly for teaching purposes and for non-profit activities.*





# ***ITMP***

## ***International Teaching Malacology Project***

### ***WHEN***

- *There are no particular needs or deadlines.*
- *Each team can decide what and when.*
- *Accepting a product for one's country is a free choice of each team, so the timing is related only to the local requirements and decisions.*
- *Members of the project are free to choose on which products to work on, according to their constraints and time availability.*


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
